In this virtual academy, an international expert faculty of specialist interstitial lung disease (ILD) nurses and physicians will provide teachings and personal perspectives on the role of nurses in the care of patients with idiopathic pulmonary fibrosis (IPF) and other fibrosing ILDs. The specialist panel will explore the diagnosis and monitoring of patients, including a discussion of the interaction between the nurse and the multi-disciplinary team (MDT). The meeting will also illuminate the holistic approach to patient management including the role of nutrition and eHealth, and the nurses' perspective on palliative care.
